MEET OUR GUEST SPEAKER

Jennifer Griffin

ennifer Griffin currently serves as the Pentagon-based National Security Correspondent for Fox News Channel, but her career with the organization began in 1997, just six months after the network launched. Initially assigned to the Moscow bureau, Griffin was soon named the network's Middle East correspondent and moved to the Fox bureau in Jerusalem at a time of political upheaval.

Griffin's career has included almost three decades of live coverage from several of the most significant geopolitical events of our time. She delivered live coverage of many crises in the Middle East, reporting from the Israel-Lebanon border during the 34-day war between Israel and Hezbollah in the summer of 2006 and covering the Palestinian intifada for seven years from Jerusalem. She also covered the funeral of Yasser Arafat live from Ramallah, interviewed Israeli Prime Minister Ariel Sharon more times than any other Western correspondent, and provided extensive coverage of the evacuation of Jewish settlements from the Gaza Strip in the summer of 2005.

In 2007, after more than 15 years living and working overseas, Griffin moved to Washington, D.C., with her husband, journalist Greg Myre, and their three children. Since joining the Washington bureau, she

has traveled extensively in Iraq and Afghanistan with various members of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. She flew to Islamabad, Pakistan, the day that Benazir Bhutto was assassinated in December 2007, and covered the uncertainty and aftermath of that attack in Pakistan, documenting the rise of the Taliban in Afghanistan. She and her husband have also authored a book on their time in the Middle East, *This Burning Land:*Lessons from the Front Lines of the Transformed Israeli-Palestinian Conflict.

As a reporter, Griffin is known as smart, tenacious, resilient and brave. It was those qualities, she believes, that helped her face and fight a 2009 diagnosis of Stage 3, Triple Negative breast cancer when she was only 39 years old. After 17 rounds of chemotherapy, a double mastectomy, and radiation treatments, she was declared in remission in 2010.

Griffin's first assignment after returning from treatment was an interview with General David Petraeus in Afghanistan. She continues her work from the Pentagon, but now also speaks of the importance of being an inspiration to breast cancer patients, living beyond yourself, and the power of survival mentorship.
