Each of the eight Memorial Hermann Cancer Centers is approved by the **American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer (ACoS CoC)**. Only 25% of hospitals across the country have received this recognition for exceptional care standards for cancer patients.

We are also nationally accredited for our award-winning care for the specific diagnoses of both breast and rectal cancer. The Breast Care Center at Memorial Hermann Greater Heights is accredited by The American College of Surgeons' **National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers (NAPBC)**, a designation given to centers that consistently achieve diagnosis and treatment standards.

The rectal cancer program at Memorial Hermann has also achieved accreditation by the **National Accreditation Program for Rectal Cancer (NAPRC)**. As the only hospital system in Texas with three accredited programs, Memorial Hermann continues to receive recognition for excellence in multidisciplinary care, research-supported protocols and processes, and adherence to evidence-based procedures.

Oncology Nurse Navigators

Memorial Hermann patients have access to our team of more than 20 oncology nurse navigators to help guide the cancer journey. Nurse navigators are registered nurses who have more than three years of oncology nursing experience, often with professional certifications within the clinical specialty. Every Memorial Hermann facility has at least one navigator who will serve as the point of contact for care coordination to ensure timely treatment, clinical education and access to additional resources. This supportive resource is available free of charge for every patient from diagnosis to treatment to survivorship. With the help of these specially trained registered nurses, patients are better able to focus on recovery and healing, knowing they have a dedicated advocate in their corner. Cancer Conferences

At Memorial Hermann Cancer Centers, tumor boards made up of a multidisciplinary team of cancer specialists meet weekly to plan and discuss the specifics of care delivered to individual patients. Patient progress is reviewed each week, and treatment options are discussed to ensure the best possible outcome for each patient. These planning boards

provide our patients with second and third opinions on their treatment. The specialists on the boards include:

- Medical oncologists
- Radiation oncologists
- Surgeons
- Radiologists
- Pathologists

Patient-Centered Services

In addition to leading-edge diagnostic and treatment capabilities, Memorial Hermann has many programs starting out through limited locations with intentions to expand and enhance current care services and recovery processes. Along with the nurse navigator program, these specialized services provide the support patients need during a challenging time.

Reimagine Care

In collaboration with our National partner, Reimagine Care, Memorial Hermann's Cancer Care at Home program provides 24/7 cancer symptom management with real-time access and interaction with a virtual care center staffed by nurses. This program offers education and support through a text messaging system and works with the oncology care team to connect and coordinate care beyond the cancer center and directly to the patient's home.

Behavioral Health

Because the cancer journey often has a significant psychological impact, Memorial Hermann offers community-based oncology behavioral health care for patients navigating a cancer diagnosis. Led by affiliated psychiatrists, psychologists and therapists, the Oncology Behavioral Health program provides supportive services that address the emotional and mental-health issues that can accompany a cancer diagnosis, including counseling, educational resources and a dedicated oncology nurse navigator to serve as each patient's personal guide.

KODA

For patients facing end-of-life care and decisions, Memorial Hermann's partnership with KODA Health, a digital platform that helps patients create advanced care plans for end-of-life care, allows patients to make important decisions about future health care to ensure their wishes are respected during an unexpected illness.

EUS-RFA Treatment for Pancreatic Cancer

Endoscopic ultrasound-guided radiofrequency ablation (EUS-RFA) combines chemotherapy with radio waves to destroy tumor tissues and reduce their growth to treat patients with pancreatic cancer. During this procedure, a needle is placed inside the pancreas and fixed amount of energy is delivered to kill tumor cells and activate the body's immune response against cancer.

Survivorship Centers

The Lindig Family Cancer Resource Center: Located at Memorial Hermann Memorial City Medical Center, the center provides patient-centered education as well as emotional, spiritual, nutritional and genetic support services for patients and their families regardless of where treatment is received. Events are offered both in person and virtually and include activities like Creative Healing Through Art, nutrition classes and chair yoga.

Canopy Cancer Survivorship Center: Located at Memorial Hermann The Woodlands Medical Center, Canopy is a first-of-its-kind cancer survivorship center in Greater Houston created to address the emotional, physical and social needs of those touched by cancer. Canopy enhances the quality of life for individuals affected by cancer, and for those who support them, offering approximately 50 classes and events and 100 activities each month. Services include Tai Chi, Zumba, pet therapy, Bible study, book club, prosthesis and wig fittings, support groups and individual and family counseling, and activities for children of cancer survivors.

Cancer Screening and Prevention

Memorial Hermann is on the leading edge of cancer screening and prevention, because we know that early diagnosis often leads to better results. Across Greater Houston, we care for the preventive needs of the community. Starting at age 40, women can screen for breast cancer with 3D mammograms, and we also offer a high-risk breast cancer program for women with a family history of breast cancer. Both women and men can be screened for colorectal abnormalities with colonoscopy testing beginning at age 45. Additionally, LDCT lung screening, a noninvasive exam that can identify lung cancer in an early stage, is available to current and former smokers, ages 50 and older.
